

Crochet Amigurumi Mushrooms

SUPPLIES:

- Yarn
 - Burgundy (10 yds)
 - Cream (10 yds)
- Crochet Hook (1-2 sizes smaller than recommended for yarn size)
- Polyester Filling
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

ABBREVIATIONS:

- ch – chain stitch
- slst – slip stitch
- sc – single crochet
- dc – double crochet
- hdc – half double crochet



STEM:

- Row 1 With the Cream yarn, 6 sc in Magic Ring (6 sc)
- Row 2 2 sc in each sc around (12 sc)
- Row 3 [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times (18 sc)
- Row 4 Sc in each sc around (18 sc)
- Row 5 [sc in each of the next 4 sc, then working in the front loops only, decrease by single crocheting the next 2 stitches together] 3 times (15 sc)
- Row 6 Sc in each sc around (15 sc)
- Row 7 [sc in each of the next 3 sc, then working in the front loops only, decrease by single crocheting the next 2 stitches together] 3 times (12 sc)
- Row 8 sc in each stitch around (12 sc)
- Row 9 Working in the front loops only, 2 dc in each sc around (24 dc)

Fasten off. Stuff firmly.

CAP:

- Row 1 With the BURGUNDY yarn, 6 sc in Magic Ring (6 sc)
- Row 2 2 sc in each sc around (12 sc)
- Row 3 [sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times (18 sc)

Helpful hints

NOTE: Repeating Row 4, 6, and 8 will give you a taller stem.

- Row 4 sc in each sc around (18 sc)
- Row 5 [sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] 6 times (24 sc)
- Row 6 sc in each sc around (24 sc)

If you want to add dots or embellishments to your mushroom cap, stitch them on now.

- Row 7 Working through loops on both the stem and cap, sc in each sc around to join the cap to the stem (24 sc) Each part has 24 stitches so they should line up. Stuff lightly before closing completely.
- Row 8 [sc in the next sc, 2 sc in the next sc] 6 times around (36 sc) This row can be modified to get different shapes in the mushroom for example:

Flat ruffly edge: 2 dc in each stitch

You can also add rows here to get different affects.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.



Note: Left cap was 1 sc around for last row, Middle cap was (sc, 2sc) around, and Right cap was 2 dc around. Play around with different techniques. You can always pull out the row and try something different if you don't like it.
